




How to Reach the College :



SCHOLARSHIP:

Merit basis National Scholarship from UGC and the scholarship for the students belonging to SC/ST/OBC/MOBC/Minority categories are available.

STUDENTS' UNION:

Birjhora Kanya Mahavidyalaya Students' Union is a body of general students of the college and every student is a member of this body. The office bearer elected annually by the students through the election to the "Students' Union" held as per constitution of the Union. The students union always extends cooperation to the college authority as well as the students to fulfill the objectives of the college. The General Secretary and Assistant General Secretary are also the member of different committees of the College.

ALUMNIASSOCIATION:

Birjhora Kanya Mahavidyalaya Alumni Association is a common platform of the ex-students of the Mahavidyalaya which is associate with various developmental works of this institution.

LITERARY & CULTURAL FORUM : Objective:

1. To develop the creativity among the students on literature by organising workshop on recitation, story and play writing.

2. To develop intelligence among the students by organising lectures and group discussion.

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL:

The Grievance Redressal Cell of the Mahavidyalaya deals with various problems, complains and grievances of students', regarding their campus lives.

CANTEEN FACILITIES:

The College provides a canteen for Students and Teachers on the fringe of the campus.













Code of Conduct for Students :

- 1. The student should reach at College premises before 10-30 a.m. positively as the College gate will remain closed after 10.30 A.M.
- 2. Wearing uniform is compulsory for students except on Thursday.
- 3. Students are strictly prohibited from leaving the college campus during the college hour without prior permission of the authority.
- 4. Every students should posses Identity Card with her photo affix on it duly attested by the Principal.
- 5. A Student of H.S. Classes must attend at least 75% of the total classes held during the session and for a degree student 95% attendance is compulsory.
- 6. Any form of ragging is strictly prohibited. Such activities will be dealt with strictly.
- 7. Use of Cell phones inside the classroom is strictly prohibited.
- 8. Students should refrain from any act of discrimination (Physical or Verbal) based on an individuals caste, race, religion or religious belief, colour, region, language, disability etc.



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- 9. In case of any breakages of College property by students will be regarded an offence and student will be Rave to bear the cost of the particular item.
- 10. Students are strictly forbidden from participating in Political agitations of any kind.
- 11. Students are forbidden from organizing any meeting in the college or collect money for any purpose without prior permission of the principal.
- 12. Students are forbidden from posting any post in social media that may create problems for the institution.

If any student is found breaching of the aforesaid Codes of Conduct, a disciplinary committee will be there to look after the matter. The committee will inquire into the alleged violation and accordingly recommend suitable disciplinary action against the said student. The committee may suggest one or more disciplinary action against the student depending on the nature of misconduct. The Principal is the authority to frame and issue any disciplinary rules whenever necessary.

Anti Ragging Cell :

In conformity with supreme court judgment and directions, UGC guidelines and State Government instructions, Birjhora Kanya Mahavidyalaya has established an Anti Ragging Cell with a zero tolerance policy towards ragging. The cell organises awareness campaigns among the students regarding the consequences of ragging.

Anti Ragging Squad :

The Anti Ragging Squad is constituted to maintain vigil, oversight and patrolling function to prohibit any act of ragging. The Squad always remains mobile, alert and active throughout to ensure that not a single incidence of ragging occurs inside the college campus. The Squad has the authority to investigate incidents of ragging and forward recommendations to Anti Ragging Cell. A student found guilty of indulging in any kind of ragging will be liable for strict disciplinary action and punishment according to the intensity of the act.



Anti Sexual Harassment Cell:

An Anti Sexual Harassment Cell has been functioning in the college with the aim to prevent sexual assault, rape and other related crimes on students, teaching and non-teaching staff. The cell set up for the purpose to provide a free and safe atmosphere to the students of the college free from sexual harassment.

Jurisdiction:

Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell assures all the complaints of the students, teaching and non-teaching staffs are treated with dignity and respect. The rules and regulations outlined in this policy shall be applicable to all complaints of sexual harassment made:

- By a member of the institution against any other member of the same institution, if the harassment is alleged to have taken place within or outside the campus.
- By a member of the institution against outsider or by an outsider against a member of the college if the sexual harassment is alleged to have taken place within the campus.

Functions:

The cell will organize awareness programmes and campaigns for the benefit of all members of the college on sexual harassment and gender based discrimination.

Students' Grievance Redressal Cell :

As suggested by University Grants Commission, New Delhi, Birjhora Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Bongaigaon has established a Students' Grievance Redressal Cell provide a mechanism for redressal of students grievances and ensure the transparency in admission and prevention of unfair practices etc. The function of the cell is to look into the complaints lodged by any student and judge its merit. The cell is also empowered to look into the matters of harassment. Anyone with a genuine grievance may approach the department members in person or in consultation with the chairman or co-ordinator of the cell. In case the person is unwilling to appear in self, grievances may be dropped in written at the Complaint/Suggestion Box placed at near Principal cabin and Girls Common room. Grievances may also be sent through email or college website to the chairperson/co-ordinator of Students Grievance Redressal Cell.

Internal Assessment :

a) Sessional or mid-term examination will be conducted for 50% of the total marks allotted for Internal Assessment of a courst/paper. (For example, if 20 marks is allotted for Internal Assessment of a course/paper, then 10 marks will be kept aside for assessment in sessional or midterm examination. The sessional examination will be held for 30 marks for the convenience of setting questions and covering the syllabus and the marks secured by the students will be proportionately converted to be out of 10 marks.

b) 20% of the marks allotted for Internal Assessment will be awarded to the students based on class attendance. If the total marks for Internal Assessment is 20, then 4 marks will be awarded to the students based on class attendance. The following criteria will be adopted for awarding marks under this category :

- i) Class attendance from 76% to 80% 1 mark;
- ii) Class attendance from 81% to 85% 2 marks;
- iii) Class attendance from 86% to 90%. 3 marks;
- iv) Class attendance from 91% and above......4 marks.

c) Rest 30% of the marks allotted for Internal Assessment will be distributed and awarded on the basis of performance of the students on the following criteria :

- i) Home assignments;
- ii) Seminar/Group discussions;
- iii) Field work;
- iv) Performance in co-curricular and extracurricular activities.
